CFM logs more than 2,100 engine orders in 2019

Orders valued at more than \$30.7 billion U.S. at list price
Delivered more than 2,100 engines

WEST CHESTER, Ohio, 28 February 2020 — CFM International received orders and commitments for a total of 2,148 engines in 2019 at a value of more than \$30.7 billion U.S. at list price, including 180 CFM56 engines (commercial, military and spares) and 1,968 LEAP engines (including spares).

Since the first LEAP engine orders in 2011, CFM has garnered more than 19,010 total installed and spare engine orders and commitments through December 2019 at a value of more than \$275 billion U.S. at list price. The company also signed long-term Rate Per Flight Hour (RPFH) agreements with airlines to support their LEAP engine fleet operations.

The company delivered 1,736 LEAP installed and spare engines in 2019 compared to 1,118 engines in 2018, along with 391 CFM56 engines.

"2019 was a solid year for CFM. The LEAP family continued to be the engine of choice for new single-aisle aircraft – we surpassed 19,000 total orders - and the continued confidence our customers have shown in our products is humbling.
