This letter authorizes SAFRAN Aircraft Engine Services Americas S.A. de C.V. Certification No. 3SMY129B to perform maintenance and modifications on aeronautical products, excluding aircraft, under TCCA regulatory control pursuant to Section B, Paragraph 4.0, of the FAA/TCCA Maintenance Implementation Procedures (MIP).

This authorization is limited to CFM56-5A/-5B/-7B engine series & LEAP-1A/-1B engine series manufactured by CFM International and the work performed must be within the ratings and limitations contained in your 14 CFR Part 145 certificate, operations specifications and capability list Revision 30, dated March 4, 2019. Any changes applied to your certificate, operations specifications, or capability list will invalidate this authorization and a new authorization request will be required by TCCA.

This TCCA authorization shall remain in effect until SAFRAN Aircraft Engine Services Americas S.A. de C.V. FAA Repair Station Certificate expires, September 30, 2020, or if the Certificate has been surrendered, suspended or revoked. In order to renew this authorization, TCCA requires SAFRAN Aircraft Engine Services Americas S.A. de C.V. to provide their renewed certificate, and demonstrate compliance with the MIP Section B, Paragraph 4.1, as part of their new authorization request.
